
REGULATIONS

1. Rules in application

The 12th Luxembourg Euro - Meet will be held under the rules of FINA and of the Luxembourg Swimming Federation (FLNS). Every swimmer can participate, who is registered through his/her club or national federation, which is as well registered with FINA.

2. Pool

The 12th Luxembourg Euro – Meet will be held on **29 –31 January 2010** in the olympic pool of the Aquatic Center of the “Coque” in Luxembourg – Kirchberg.
The competition pool has 10 lanes à 50m, depth 2,20m all through, water temperature 26°C, electronic OMEGA timing.
A 6 x 50 m training pool and a 25 m warm –up pool are available in the same building throughout the meeting.

3. Program and beginning of the races

The program will take place according to the details of the races published in the joined invitation. The beginning of the races may be changed if the number of entries make it necessary.

5. Finals

Direct finals in the age groups: Events 1 – 6
A and B finals for the fastest 20 swimmers of the heats, independent of their age group.: Events 7 - 22 and 25 – 32.
For events 23 – 24 only A finals will take place for the fastest 10 swimmers.
Classification in the age groups Junior and Youth according to the results in the heats.

6. Entries and Entry fee

The entries should preferably be made in the “LENEX” format. The program for this type of entries can be downloaded under www.flns.lu.

We can handle other electronic entries in the forms: SDIF, DSV-Format, W.A.S. XML.

Otherwise the entries shall be made on the joined entry forms which can also be found under www.flns.lu . The entry times shall be 50 m pool times not older than 12 months.

The entry fee is 12.00 Euro for each individual entry. The OC will reimburse 4,00 Euro for each individual result reaching the time standard in the heats. The restitution will be paid on Sunday January 31th 2010 after the heats at the reception desk. No restitution will be paid for absence.

7. Deadline for Entry Forms

8. Welcome Desk

A welcome team will be in place at Luxembourg airport and at the railway station in Luxembourg. A welcome desk will be open at the pool from **Thursday January 28nd 2010 at 18.00 hours on.**

9. Local Transport

Local transport will be organised by the OC from the Luxembourg airport and from the railway station in Luxembourg to the Novotel. A shuttle will be running between the pool and the hotels for which reservation has been made through the OC except for the Novotel which is at walking distance to the pool. Teams which have not reserved their hotel through the OC are responsible for their own local transport.

10. Accommodation and Meals - Forms under www.flns.lu

Accommodation can be booked through the OC at the Novotel which is at 5 minutes walking distance from the Olympic Pool. The Novotel will only accept bookings through the OC.

Accommodation can also be booked in other hotels. If asked, the OC can help to make other Hotel bookings.

During the competition days, the OC offers the possibility to take lunch and dinner at the pool restaurant. Reservation for the meals should be made for January 15th 2010 with the available meal form.

11. Prizes

In the age group "Open" prize money will be paid to the three first of each event, 1st 250 €, 2nd 150 €, 3rd 100 €. In the age groups "Junior" and "Youth" medals will be awarded to the 3 first swimmers in each event. To get the prizes the limit times of the OC must be reached.

12. Records

For records the following prizes will be given:

World Record	2.500 €
European Record	1.000 €
Meet Record	100 €.

13. Team classification

For the team-classification the 30 best results of one team (conferring to the FINA point table) realised in the heats will be considered. For the teams having less than 30 entries all results will be considered. The team realising the highest total point score will receive 1.000 €, the second classified team 600€ and the third team will get 400 €.

14. Results

One result will be available for each team in its pigeon box at the welcome desk in the pool. The results will also be published at two different points in the pool. Results are also published under www.flns.lu and under the official European ranking list www.swimrankings.net.

15. Training and warm-up

Warm up and training at the competition pool is possible Friday to Sunday from 1 ½ hour until 15 minutes before the sessions.

In the 6 x 50m training pool training is possible on Thursday from 16.00-21.00 hours, Friday from 10.00 hours until the end of the competition, Saturday and Sunday from 7.30 hours until the end of the competition. For additional training please contact the O. C.

FINA has approved the 12th Luxembourg Euro - Meet as a meet where swimmers can achieve the FINA "A" and "B" Swimming Qualifying Standard Times for the 1st Youth Olympic Games – Singapore 2010.
